DISASTER RECOVERY CENTER OPENS IN WADENA, OTTER TAIL COUNTIES

ST. PAUL — The Minnesota Department of Public Safety Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (HSEM) announced today the opening of disaster recovery centers (DRC) for residents in Wadena and Otter Tail counties.
