## What's Recyclable?

### Plastic

Bottles/jugs with a number 1 or 2 on them. No brown plastic. All containers must have a neck or spout.

### Glass

Ceramics, dishes, glasses and window glass (excluding the frame) may also be recycled with bottles and jars.

*Light bulbs and automotive glass are not accepted.*

### Tin and Aluminum Cans

### Newspaper/Phone Books Other Paper

Recycle computer/office paper — bundle and separate from newspaper.

*Magazines, catalogs, shiny and glossy paper are accepted at special collections.*

### Corrugated Cardboard

Flatten boxes.
